

Nurse Practitioner- Part Time Arlington Free Clinic

Arlington Free Clinic is a community-based nonprofit organization committed to advancing health equity by providing free, whole-person healthcare for our neighbors who would otherwise lack access. We offer comprehensive services onsite including primary and specialty care, behavioral health, and dental care. We are seeking an experienced **Nurse Practitioner** to play an essential role in ensuring high quality, patient-centered care and work closely with our patients to make a difference in their lives.

You will be responsible for:

- Provide medical care for minor acute illnesses and provide comprehensive care for a panel of patients needing intensive medical management.
- Develop and manage NP clinical activities, including patient scheduling, chart review, patient care and follow-up.
- Coordinate with director for activities involving clinical administration, appointment scheduling, patient referrals, etc.
- Support pharmacy team in ensuring timely access to medications and identifying additions to the formulary.
- Identify important clinical trends, concerns, problems, or suggestions that need to be considered.
- Determine medical emergencies and take appropriate action.
- Discuss unusual medical cases and concerns with the clinical/medical director.

We are looking for someone who:

- Enjoys working independently and collaboratively, as part of a team.
- Experience with or is excited about working in a safety-net clinic.
- Is highly organized and can coordinate a variety of tasks simultaneously.

This position might be a good fit for someone who:

- Likes to be challenged to use critical thinking skills to ensure high quality patient care.
- Is self-directed and likes making independent decisions
- Is curious about how to overcome barriers to improving healthcare for the uninsured
- Prefers a 20 hour a week part time position

Requirements:

- Master's degree in nursing, certified as a nurse practitioner. Autonomous practice preferred.
- Current NP Virginia license.
- Comprehensive understanding of clinical procedures, patient care procedures, medical protocols and testing procedures.
- Two to five years of experience serving a low-income population in a health care setting.

- Bilingual in English and Spanish preferred,
- Current BCLS certification.
- Prior experience working with volunteers.
- Demonstrates excellent clinical knowledge and the ability to provide high quality, patient-centered healthcare.
- Demonstrates excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
- Prior experience working with volunteers preferred.
- Ability to uphold and maintain confidentiality of patients and clinic information.
- Ability to document patient care completely and appropriately in EHR.

This is a part-time position working 20 hours primarily on weekdays with some evening hours as needed. Excellent benefits package including health insurance/dental/401(k) retirement plan, ten paid holidays, paid time off and free parking. Interested candidates must be willing to be fully vaccinated against Covid -19.
