Vaccines

Women, Infants & Children (WIC)

If you're a pregnant woman, a new mom, or have kids under five, Arlington County offers services to keep you and your family healthy. Services include supplemental food, nutrition counseling and education, breastfeeding support, immunizations, and referrals to health and social services.

Community Health

Clinic services include family planning, maternity care, free school entry exams for students who are uninsured or underinsured, basic GYN care, pregnancy testing, emergency contraception, pap smear/cervical cancer screenings, and mammogram referrals.
