KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide mental health therapy to patients, under supervision of a Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC).
- Conduct behavioral health assessment and triage patients with mental/behavioral health concerns.

- Educate staff and volunteers on relevant behavioral health topics.
- Lead therapy and psychoeducational groups.
- Coordinate patient care in collaboration with clinical and behavioral health teams.
- Offer empathetic, compassionate support to all patients.
- Provide emergency interventions as needed.
- Advocate for patients' rights and services.
- Ensure accurate, timely completion of medical records.
- Track and report data for behavioral health grants.

- Eligible for **Resident in Counseling** license within 2 months of employment and working toward LPC licensure
- Fluency in English and Spanish, written and spoken required.

- Ability to empathize with patients / clients to provide for a safe and trusting therapeutic relationship.
